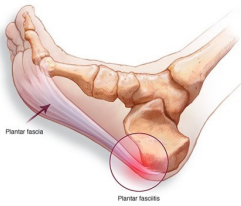


PLANTAR HEEL PAIN - EVALUATION & MANAGEMENT
