Dear Alpesh Patel:

Beginning January 2001, all PTs and PTAs in Texas will be required by law to complete two hours of continuing competence in ethics and professional responsibility prior to renewing their licenses. The Texas Board of Physical Therapy Examiners has stipulated that the ethics/professional responsibility course should include at a minimum the following components:

1. The theoretical basis for ethical decision-making.
2. APTA's Code of Ethics and Guide for Professional Conduct.
3. Legal standards of behavior (including but not limited to practice acts and rules).
4. Hypothetical case scenarios.

Your application for approval of "Ethics and Professional Responsibility for Physical Therapists and Physical Therapist Assistants," course approval number 51867EA, has been evaluated on the basis of these four criteria and determined to meet the requirements for classification as an approved ethics and professional responsibility course. Please note the course number has been modified from the original approval letter to reflect the addition of ethics credit.
