

TEXAS NURSING JURISPRUDENCE AND ETHICS



The purpose of Nursing Jurisprudence and Ethics for Texas Nurses is to inform nurses about the Texas Nurse Practice Act and Board of Nursing (BON) Rules, Including Board Rule 217.11, Standards of Nursing Practice, Texas BON Position Statements, principles of nursing ethics, and professional boundaries.

- Outline the Texas nursing practice and the general scope of practice of each nursing specialties.
- Identify specific laws and rules related to the practice of nursing in Texas.
- Differentiate between ethical and legal practice.
- Discuss the legal and ethical requirements related to professional boundaries and unprofessional conduct in nursing.
